Geoff was the chief designer and builder when the Community Center was renovated and expanded in the late 1990s. Subsequently, he built the pavilion to cover the generator and walk-in refrigeration



Food Cabinet Grant and Enhancements

United Way of Tompkins County just awarded the Varna Community Association a grant from the United Tompkins Impact Fund to dramatically improve our blue mutual aid food cabinet and cooler.

At Thanksgiving 2020, we received a cooler for donated Thanksgiving meals, which we kept going with ice packs, repairs, and regular cleaning In 2021, we had installed a heater in the cabinet to make it possible to keep canned goods available in the cabinet during all but the coldest days of winter.

The current setup fits awkwardly in our front entrance, and requires constant maintenance. It is wonderful to have a system that lets anyone contribute, but the community center has kept the cabinet in good shape.

The grant will let us build a new cabinet, with a garage-ready refrigerator and a simple heating system that will let all of the parts work year round. We will still have to check on it, as sometimes people leave the doors open, but we'll be able to build something much more solid and easier to work around. We'll have more space for both stable and fresh foods, while also having more useful space.

The refrigerator is already there, and we'll be building the new cabinet around it this fall.

Trail enhancements in the works

The VCA has been working on the trail connecting

the playground behind the VCA with the rail trail. While there is still a lot to do. especially for the times when the trail is muddy. we've started with an outdoor trash can near the playground. Hopefully it will help us avoid litter on both the trails and playground.
